Lieut. Butler *Brum*, *Comd'g* the
Co. Cutler's, that applicant received a gun shot-
wound through the left side at the Battle of
Quincy Hill on June 27th 1862.

Dr. Wm. A. Jackson, *Exam. Surgeon*
certifies that applicant is totally disabled by wound
of gun shot wound in the cardiac region between the
5th & 6th ribs the 5th rib being shattered by the ball,
passing behind the heart; where it now appears to
be lodged in the right sub-scapular muscle.

Admitted *April 7th*, 1863, to a pension of \$ *8.00* per month, commencing
November 14th, 1862
