AD 1862 being engaged in Battle at or near
a place called Gaines Hill in the State of Virginia
he received a gun shot wound through his
left side and lung. Entering in left side
a little in front and lodging under the right
shoulder blade, and he is thereby not only
incapacitated for military duty, but in the
opinion of the undersigned, is totally disabled
from obtaining his subsistence from manual
labor.
