ON THIS twenty fourth day of December A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two personally appeared before me, the Clerk of the Circuit Court within and for the County and State aforesaid, Edwin Barlow aged Twenty years, a resident of Fushing in Genesee County in the State of Michigan who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Edwin Barlow who enlisted in the service of the United States as a private in the Company (C) commanded by Capt. T. G. Lane now by Capt. G. S. Lane in the sixteenth Regiment of Michigan Volunteers commanded by Col. T. B. W. Stockton in the War for the Suppression of the Rebellion in the Southern States, and was honorably discharged on the fourteenth day of November in the year 1862; that, while in the service aforesaid, and in the line of his duty, he became disabled at the time and place, and in the manner following, to wit:

By a gun shot wound through the left side and lung entering in left side a little in front and lodging under the right shoulder blade. On the 27th day of June AD 1862. at the Battle of Gaines Hill in the State of Virginia. That his disability is total. That he has been wholly unable to labor at any occupation since being so wounded and is now unable to gain his living by manual labor and that his occupation before enlisting was that of a farmer

The said Edwin Barlow makes this Declaration for the purpose of obtaining the benefit of the Invalid Pension Laws of the United States; and doth hereby constitute and appoint Oscar Adams of Flint Mich his true and lawful Attorney with full power of substitution, authorizing Him to prosecute this, his Claim for a Pension, and to receive and receipt for any Draft or Certificate which may be issued thereon, and to do all other acts which may be necessary in the premises.
