

Declaration for the Increase of an Invalid Pension.

TAKE NOTICE.—If this declaration is executed before a Justice of the Peace or a Notary Public, the certificate of the CLERK OF THE COURT, as to the official character and genuineness of the signature of such officer must be attached. Neglect to comply with this requirement will cause trouble and DELAY.

ON THIS 5th day of July A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty four
personally appeared before me, a Notary Public within and for the County and State
aforesaid, Eduvin Barlow aged forty two years, a resident of
Columbia County of Brown State of
Dakota, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of the
United States, enrolled at the Detroit Mich Pension Agency at the rate of Six
dollars per month, Certificate No. 10800, by reason of disability from Gun shot wound

Was taken prisoner and taken to Libby Prison from the
Battlefield) and remained there 96 days then taken
to Bellevue Hospital New York City
from there taken to Fort Wayne; to Brooklyn N.Y.
Was treated for such wound from the time it was
had. until Nov. 14th 1862 when he was discharged
at Warrenton City V. R. and was taken home
Home on a stretcher

that he hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation,

his true and lawful attorney, to prosecute his claim.
