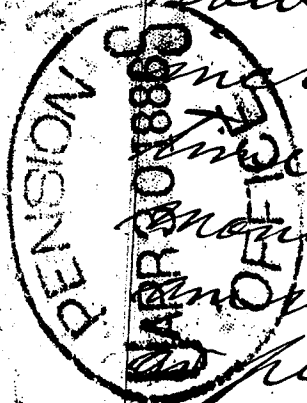

increased until at the present
time I am wholly unable to perform
manual labor of any kind &
unable to walk any distance
or perform other exercise without
constant resting and great
pain I would therefore petition
you to grant me an increase
of said pension Edwin Barlow
