

## Officer's Certificate to Disability of Soldier.

State of Virginia  
County of Stafford

I, Butler Browne do hereby certify that I am 1<sup>st</sup> Lieutenant  
Company C of the 16 Regiment of Mich Volunteers, and am acquainted  
with Edwin Barlow who was a member of my Company, and as I am informed is  
an applicant for an Invalid Pension. That the said Edwin Barlow was mustered  
into service on or about the 9 day of August 1861, and discharged for disability about  
the 14<sup>th</sup> day of November 1862, having become disabled from doing duty as a soldier from  
wounds received in battle  
on or about the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 1862, while in the service of the United States  
and in the line of his duty as a soldier, in the manner and at the place as follows: By a gun

shot wound through the left side and lung. Entering in  
left side a little in front, and the ball lodging under  
the right shoulder blade. Said wound was received  
while in Battle at Gaines Hill in the State of  
Virginia on or about the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 1862.

That the said soldier was in good health at the time he entered the service, and the disability above  
referred to affected him while in the service and at his discharge, as follows: By totally  
disabling him from performing duty as a  
soldier, and also from performing any labor.
